- **EXCLAMATION MARKS** ARE USED AT THE END OF STRONG OR FORCEFUL SENTENCES, **EX:** LOOK AT THAT HUGE BEAR!
- **A COMMA** IS USED TO SEPARATE WORDS OR GROUP OF WORDS, **EX:** MY SHIRT IS BLUE, RED, PURPLE AND YELLOW.
- **USE A SEMI-COLON** INSTEAD OF AND BETWEEN TWO INDEPENDENT CLAUSES, **EX:** WE CAN GO TO THE LIBRARY TO DO SOME READING; MONDAYS ARE PRETTY QUIET THERE.
