REQUIRED APPROVALS:

- The Cree School Board reviewed and approved the Strategic Action Plan set to roll out for 2021-2026 in the schools by phases.
- A review of the Teacher Training Program's budget allocations.
- Extending the three-year Funding Agreement with the Government of Canada.
- Approval of the Personnel Plan, which includes the creation and elimination of positions at CSB.
- Mistissini facilities security upgrades, including Voyageur Memorial High School, Voyageur Memorial Elementary School, Head Office, and Warehouse.
- Hiring of architecture companies to ensure that schools and other facilities are maintained and improved, and that new learning centres and housing units are built across the nine communities.
- Approval of a Service Agreement with LBGR Consulting Inc. to offer technology services and software development to improve the funding application process for Sabtuan Adult Education Services and Post-Secondary Student Services.
