## September 8, 2020



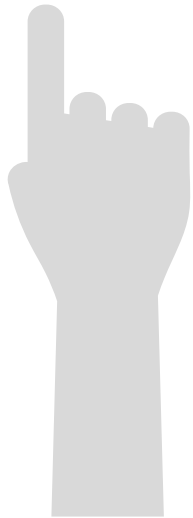
### **To return to adult education on September 8, you must:**

- Be a continuing student (attended last year before the closures)
- Have completed an online application through our website
- Have received confirmation of your return (will be sent through email)

**If you are not a continuing student from last year, you may apply on September 1 and begin later in the Fall.**

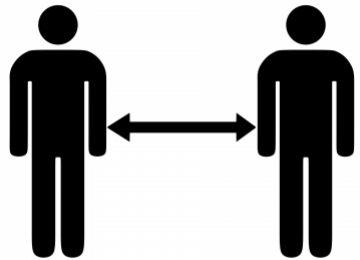

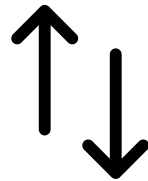

## To allow for physical distancing, we will:

- Offer General Education courses partially online so groups can rotate out of the classroom space
- Review each Vocational Program and adjust projects/spaces to ensure distancing is possible

# Why is physical distancing/partial online learning in place for adult education?

- 1 Public health advice** - current public health advice requires all adults to distance from one another. Adults in all sectors of the Cree School Board (staff, teachers, parents) will be required to distance from one another.
- 2 Community well-being** - many of our students have children, who will be in their own stable class groups at school. By distancing adults, households will can continue limiting their circle of contact.
- 3 Future preparedness** - by preparing our students with online learning skills and equipment from the start of the school year, we will be prepared to switch to a fully online model in the case of a second wave, outbreak, or risk level increase.
- 4 Learning skills & growth** – improved online learning skills and computer skills will serve our students wherever their education or career takes them!

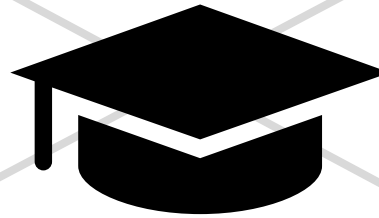
# Supporting Your Success

## Frequently Asked Questions: Adult Education Programs and Student Allowances

### General Information: Sabtuan Adult Education Services' Reopening

When will adult education classes start for the new school year?

**August 1-15** Application period for continuing students (students who attended adult education last year). All students must apply online [here](#) if they wish to return in September.

**September 8** Return date for continuing students in General Education and most Vocational Training Programs

**September 21** Return date for Professional Cooking at SRVTC

**Later in Fall** Start date for new and returning students (those who enrolled in the past but did not attend last year). Applications for these students will be available starting in September.

What programs are available at Sabtuan Adult Education Services this year?

SAES will be offering General Education (Upgrading) in all communities starting in the Fall. We will also continue with all Vocational Training Programs that were put on hold due to COVID-19 closures in September.

New Vocational Training Programs will be announced later this year, in accordance with public health measures. To receive updates on available programs, please join our mailing list [here](#).

What health & safety measures will be in place to protect students from COVID-19?

As Eeyou Itstchee is now in Phase 3 of COVID-19 reopening, certain public health measures must be respected. These include social distancing and partial online learning. Students will be provided with full information on health & safety measures in advance of their return to school.

I am a student at Sabtuan Regional Vocational Training Centre (SRVTC). Will the residence and cafeteria reopen?

Both the student residence and cafeteria will reopen in September, along with the restart of our programs. However, there will be changes to meal procedures, residence security, and access to student areas. All students and staff will be expected to maintain social distancing, and all equipment will be sanitized between uses. Full information on the new procedures will be provided to staff and students in advance of the new school year.
