#### TO ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS RESPECTING THE ELECTION OF CHAIRPERSON OF THE CREE SCHOOL

Notice is hereby given to the Electors of the Cree Nation (of Eeyou Istchee) that the following is the Final List of Candidates for the election of Chairperson of the Cree School Board:

- **Abraham Jolly;**
- **Sarah Pash.**

The Chairperson is elected by and from among the members of the Cree Nation Government for a term of three (3) years. The present notice is in accordance with “*Consolidated By-Law No. 1 – General By-Law*” and “*Consolidated By-Law No. 2 Respecting Procedures for the Election of the Chairperson of the Cree School Board*”.

The date of the election is scheduled on **Wednesday, July 28, 2021** and the eligible electors can vote on any of the following polling stations:

- Whapmagoostui – WFN Gathering Place;
- Chisasibi – Mitchuap building;
- Wemindji – Community Hall;
- Eastmain – Band Office building;
- Waskaganish – Gathering Place;
- Nemaska – Recreation Hall;
- Waswanipi – Waswanipi Fitness Health Center;
- Ouje-bougoumou – Youth Center (advance Poll) and Band Office (Council of Chambers) for Election Day;
- Mistissini – Youth Center;
- Washaw Sibi – Band office building (141 route, 111 ouest Amos);
- MoCreebec – administrative building in Moose Factory.

**ADVANCE POLL:** Wednesday, July 21, 2021 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

An advance poll shall be held for those electors who are unable to vote in person at the principal poll (election day) because of work, family responsibilities, or absence from the community.

**MAIN ELECTION POLL:** Wednesday, July 28, 2021 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**VOTING BY TELEPHONE: On both dates & time – July 21 & 28**

In order to ensure that the election poll is carried out safely in view of the on-going public health emergency, if necessary, the Returning Officer may authorize certain voters to participate in the ***poll by telephone*** where he deems it appropriate, such as:

- For eligible voters located in “COVID-19 Areas of Risk” determined by the Cree authorities;
- For the eligible voters who are unable to vote in person due to long-term illness or physical disability;
- For eligible voters who are in self-isolation in accordance with the “local mandatory self-isolation Law”, and;
- For eligible voters who reside in other locations where there is no polling station or workers at Mining camps, as may be authorized by the Returning Officer.

**TRAVELLING POLL:** Thursday, July 22, 2021 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

A travelling poll may take place for the elders who reside in the community or community members who reside in Cree camps and traplines and are unable to vote on the election day due to physical disability or other limitations.



**Qualifications to Vote**

The qualifications to vote in the election of the Chairperson of the Cree School Board are as follows:

- To be a member of the Cree Nation (enrolled or entitled to be as a Cree beneficiary of the *James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement*) who is in possession of a valid community beneficiary number in accordance with the applicable electoral list, as provided by Cree Nation Government;
- Be the age of majority (eighteen (18) years of age or over on the date of the election;
- And not to be affected by any legal incapacity or subject to protective supervision within the meaning of the Civil Code of Québec.
