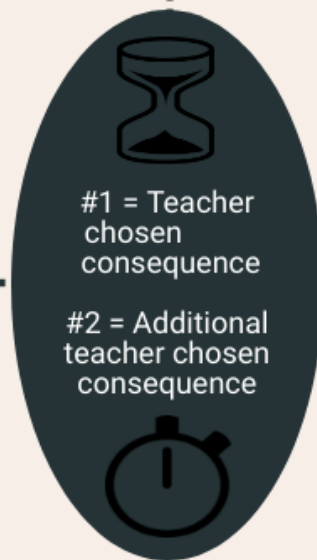

Classroom

- Leave lights on
- Only enter storage room with teacher permission

Library

- Put books you have read on the book cart
- Return books on time and in good condition

Kitchen

- Enter only with adult permission
- Wash all materials used
- Put away materials in the correct spot

Outside

- Stay on school property
- Rocks, sand and snow stay on the ground
- Report problems to the adult on duty
- Return toys to the proper place

Assembly

- Sit in designated spot and remain seated
- Only go on stage with permission
- Respond politely
- Maintain the aisles

Computer Lab

- Only go on teacher approved sites
- No food or drinks
- Keep the school approved desktops and screensavers
- Log out when done

Staffroom

- Knock before entering
- Wait for a teacher to greet you
- Stay on task, then return to class
- Clean up any mess you've made
